

McCann's School of Dance - Classroom dress policy.

Dress requirements

Ballet students ages 8 and under – Students must wear leotards and tights, sheer skirts may be worn. Hair must be pulled back off the face.

Shoes required - Pink soft Ballet slippers.

Shoes recommended - Revolution ballet Leather shoe with no drawstring sold at the studio, at the beginning of the year and in the spring before the show.

Ballet students ages 9 and up Students must wear leotards, tights. These students may not wear skirts. Hair must be completely secured in a tight bun.

Shoes required - Pink soft split-sole Ballet slippers.

Shoes recommended - Revolution Premium split-sole sold at the studio, at the beginning of the year and in the spring before the show.

Jazz - Students may wear leotards and tights or a shirt with Jazz (yoga) pants or exercise shorts. No large shirts, jeans or regular pants allowed.

Shoe Requirement - Black jazz shoes with split sole.

Shoe recommended – Revolution Black Jazz split sole shoe or boot sold at the studio.

Hip Hop - Loose fitting pants and shirts may be worn.

Shoe Requirement – Black dance sneakers or regular sneakers.

Tap - Students may wear leotards and tights or a shirt with Jazz (yoga) pants or exercise shorts. No large shirts, jeans or regular pants allowed. Tap shoes must be in good repair, no loose taps.

Shoe Requirement – See Tap Shoe Chart posted on website and posted in the studio for the shoes required for your tap class.

Adult Ballet/Jazz - Students should wear exercise clothing.

Shoes required - Black Jazz shoes with split sole.

Creative Movement - Students should wear leotards and tights. Skirts may be worn. Hair should be pulled back off the face.

Shoes required - Pink soft Ballet slippers.

Shoes recommended - Revolution ballet Leather shoe with no drawstring sold at the studio, at the beginning of the year.

Note: Do not wear any of your dance footwear outside of the studio. This is for your safety and for the protection of the dance floors.

Hair- Students hair must be pulled back off of the face during class. In order to maximize instructional time, students should come to class with hair and dress prepared as described above. Please have extra supplies (hair ties, bobby pins and head bands) in students' dance bag.
